Information Learned From State Energy Office Interviews

- SC Labeling Pilot Program Model
 - SC pathway similar to Oregon and Missouri labeling programs
 - SC Energy Office to be DOE HES Program Partner for labeling implementation
 - Labeling vendor to provide infrastructure to run labeling program, training for assessors and assist Energy Office in managing program
 - Adoption by local jurisdictions recommended as best pathway for effective implementation

Next Steps


- Bring "Quick Start" Vendor Onboard
